PhD & POST-DOC SCHOLARSHIPS ADVERTISEMENT PRE-SELECTION OF CANDIDATES

The Swedish International Development Agency (SIDA) project "Strengthening African higher education research and expertise through establishing a joint programme" entitled *Comparative Higher Education, Policy and Innovation Studies (CHEPIS)* for doctoral degree and post-doctoral fellowships is offering 7 (Seven) scholarships to candidates from Mozambique interested in pursuing PhD studies, starting in 2018:

- 4 (four) scholarships to pursue a double PhD degree under the joint programme CHEPIS, at the FACED, UEM, in partnership with the *History of Technology, Science and Environmentm programme, & Department of Learning in Engineering Sciences, School of Industrial Engineering and Management (ITM)* at the KTH Royal Institute of Technology in Stockholm, Sweden; for candidates from any scientific area;
- 3 (three) scholarships to pursue a joint PhD in *Higher Education Studies* at FACED, UEM, in partnership with the Institute for Post-School Studies at University of the Western Cape (IPSS/UWC), Cape Town, South-Africa;
- 2 (two) scholarships for Post-doctoral Research fellows, for candidates from any scientific area.

Candidates must fulfil the following requirements:

- Completion of an Academic or professional Master's degree in any area of knowledge, with an average of not less than 14 (60%) marks or equivalent;
- Total of credits equivalent to the Academic Master's Degree (for the candidates holding a professional Master's Degree);
- Completed PhD not more than three years ago (for post-doctoral fellowships)

Candidates must submit the hardcopy and the electronic version of the following documents to the Academic Registrar office FACED, by **May 9th, 2018, 12 pm**, Mozambican time.

- An application letter addressed to the Dean of the Faculty requesting the award of the scholarship;
- 2 (two) letters of recommendation from previous lecturers/supervisors;
- 1 (one) letter from the candidate's workplace confirming that he/she will get a study leave should he/she receive the scholarship (where applicable);
- Curriculum vitae;
- Research proposal of approximately 10 pages, in English, including aim, methods, theory, empirical approach;
- Two peer-reviewed publications(for post-doctoral fellowship applicants);
- Certified copy of the Identity Card or Passport;
- Certified copy of the academic transcript and Master's Diploma (sworn translated into English);
- Proof of English proficiency, (IELTS score 7.0 or TOEFL equivalent).
